- b. What do we know about the author?
2. Most Bible introductions describe the nation to whom the author addresses this letter. What facts do we learn about them?
3. Read through the entire Book [all 21 verses] and note the following:
 - a. Vss. 1-9. Against what capital sin does God direct these words?
On what do these people seem to rely?
 - b. Vss. 10-14. What is described in these verses?
 - c. Vss. 15-21. What judgment shall fall and what promise and encouragement are written as well?

For additional study look up the references in your Bible any or all verses and write some thoughts and/or reflections on them.
