2. Read the first 4 verses of this Book. What seems to be the problem this prophet sees in his own land?
3. How does God respond to the questioning of Habakkuk in vss. 5-11?
4. Upon hearing the Lord's words, how does Habakkuk interpret it? [1:12-17]
What words written by the prophet indicate that he knows the Lord will answer him? [2:1]
5. What is indicative of God's sovereign power in Habakkuk 2?
6. How are the Babylonians described in the remaining verses of this same chapter?
7. Spend time reflecting on the prayer recorded by Habakkuk in chapter 3. How can some of these words sum up where you are today?

For additional study look up the references in your Bible any or all verses and write some thoughts and/or reflections on them.
