**PASTOR'S CORNER**



**2019 PSA Follow Up**

You will see in this bulletin our initial response to the 2019 Pastoral Services Appeal. After speaking at all the Masses last weekend, I am grateful for the early and positive response from so many! I hope you agree that our Diocesan pastoral services and our own sanctuary remodeling project are worthy investments in the future of our church!

Here's a little back story for the sanctuary remodel. Over two years ago, Bishop Kevin Vann gave permission for moving Tabernacles in our Diocese. There are many, like St. Hedwig, whose Tabernacles are in separate rooms or are otherwise not visible from the pews. Some churches were built this way, others were remodeled over the years in this pattern (30+ years ago for St. Hedwig). Bishop Vann and I (and many other priests in OC) believe that being a Eucharist-centered Church means visibly having our Tabernacles physically and symbolically centered in our churches.

Over the past two years, as often as I saw Bishop Vann, he would ask me, "Have you moved your Tabernacle yet?" He is particularly interested in this improvement of

our church, and after two years he has finally prevailed on me to move on this!

Placing a Tabernacle behind the Altar is not simply a matter of moving furniture: this gives us an opportunity to consider how we worship together, and to increase our Eucharistic reverence and liturgical practice. Over thirty years we have grown accustomed to the Tabernacle in a different room. We will need to learn together how to interact with Christ present in the Blessed Sacrament, to genuflect, and to observe silence before and after Mass. I hope that a greater use of Catholic imagery (Mary, St. Joseph, St. Hedwig, maybe some Angels) will inspire devotion and prayer in ways we have not known here.

I also hope that creating a space that parents can quickly access with noisy children will improve the experience of Mass for everyone: not an old-fashioned "cry room" where parents are relegated for years, but a temporary space like the vestibule where parents go now, where they can neither see nor hear Mass. This will take some training, but I believe a room where a parent can take a child for a few minutes and then rejoin the congregation is a better idea than being stuck in a romper room!

Thank you again for your regular support for the ministries and services of our parish, and for your investment in our parish and diocese.

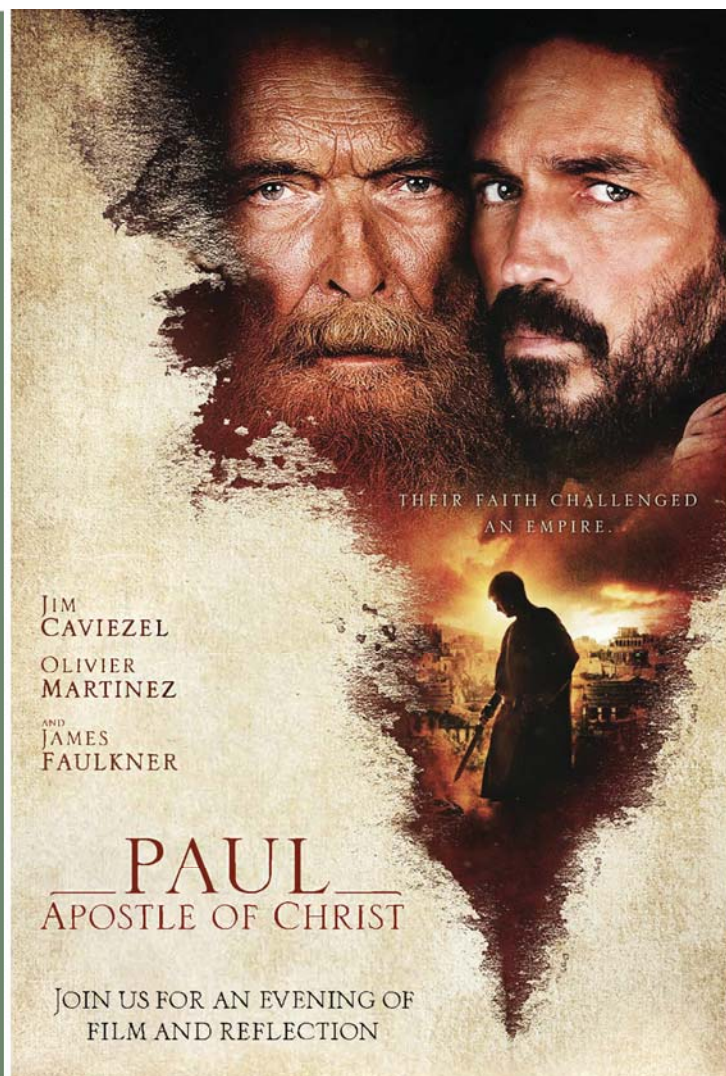
