

**PASTOR'S CORNER**



**It's almost Lent!**

This year Easter is much later than usual. Ash Wednesday is March 6th, and although it is NOT a holy day of obligation (you are not required to go to church that day), many people still want to start Lent off right with Mass and ashes.

It's important to consider in advance what you are going to do for Lent, otherwise it can catch you off guard and you'll spend the first two weeks of Lent not doing anything specific! During Lent we're asked to devote ourselves to seeking the Lord in prayer and reading Scripture, to service by giving alms, and to sacrifice self-control through fasting. Here are some things to consider-you may have others as well:

**Prayer:** Go to Mass every Sunday (we are always supposed to do this, but if you find Mass attendance difficult, just regularizing your Mass attendance is a great thing to do); go to Mass on weekdays (we have an 8:30 Mass Monday-Saturday; if our schedule doesn't fit your need see what other local parishes have to offer); daily Scripture reading (try reading the Passion narratives in all four Gospels); daily Rosary; visits to the Blessed Sacrament; daily spiritual reading; go to Confession (either a regular confession time or

a penance service); find some good Catholic programming to learn more about your faith (radio, websites); attend Holy Week Masses (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil).

**Fasting:** We are required to fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday; fasting is defined as one full meal and two partial meals that together would not equal a full meal; abstaining means specifically not eating meat, which we are also required to do on the Fridays of Lent; the rules of fasting are for healthy adults between ages 18-59, everyone over the age of 14 is required to abstain; this isn't just about food-what other things can you "fast" on? Internet usage, TV, other forms of entertainment or time-wasting activities; drinking alcohol, smoking, anything that has an addictive quality to it whether sinful or not; spring cleaning and donating your unused items to charity.

**Almsgiving:** regular parish contributions; commit to the Pastoral Services Appeal; make donations to your favorite charities and our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society; make a family budget and live by it (this could also be a fasting activity); commit to a parish ministry or some neighborhood service; spend more time with family.
