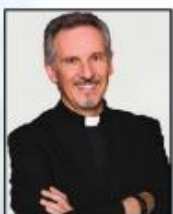

PASTOR'S CORNER



The Lord is Risen! Alleluia!

Dear Visitors and Parish Members:

The entire Christian faith and our living of it depends totally, and is centered on, the Resurrection of Jesus. Sadly, a growing number of Americans are falling for the cynicism of disbelief, calling the resurrection from the dead a myth, and our belief in the Risen Lord no different than believing in the "flying spaghetti monster" (and yes, this is a real atheist joke). The fact of the Resurrection is corroborated by several eyewitnesses and is the basis on which the spread of the Christian faith is built.

Either Jesus is Who (and What) He said He is, or He's not. Either Jesus is the Son of God or He is a charlatan or insane. The Resurrection proves His Divinity, as do the many miracles recorded in the Sacred Scriptures. For those who think the Apostles made the whole thing up, I contend that no one would think of starting a fake religion based on a lie: at some point the lie would be exposed, and no one would die a martyr's death (all but one Apostle did) to perpetuate a lie, and there were too many people involved for a lie to stay hidden for an entire generation.

And if there was an attempt to start a false religion, I contend that no one in their right mind would start it based on something as unbelievable as resurrection of the dead!

Would YOU start a movement based on something scientifically impossible, something unheard of and never experienced by anyone? When St. Paul when to Athens to preach the Gospel for the first time, he was laughed off the stage when he brought up resurrection (see Acts 17, especially v. 32-33).

The internal evidence of the truths that Jesus is Lord and that He really rose from the dead is all there in the Bible and backed up by 2000 years of Christian teaching and practice. What made the unbelievable believable wasn't just logic or philosophy or the ability to quote Scripture. What ultimately made Christianity believable was how that first generation of Christians lived – and died – for the faith. And that's what makes our Catholic Christian faith believable today: how WE live it. If we are inconsistent or say one thing and do another, why should anyone follow us? If we aren't merciful and generous and prayerful and peaceful and hopeful, we cannot well advertise Christianity well!

To all who join us today, Easter Sunday, I invite you to consider how well you walk the walk. If we say we believe but don't live it and weekly celebrate it, then it's time to reconsider our priorities. If you have been away for a while, I invite you to take another look at the ancient teachings of our faith and ask yourself if it's time to return to a community that daily and weekly strives (not always well) to practice what we preach. The Church is the sinners' club, not a group of self-righteous saved people, but a family trying to live what we believe! Maybe you need this too?
