PASTOR'S CORNER



Life Reflection

This year is the 30th year of my ordination to the priesthood. I'm sharing a picture taken October 1st, 1988 with my parents, Bonnie and Ned Heath, both, I'm happy to say, are still alive. My parents encouraged my vocation to the priesthood and for this I am eternally grateful. This being Father's Day, I thought I'd take a moment to honor my Dad for how he raised me and my three younger brothers. Both my parents experienced hardship in their younger years, and they tried mightily to ensure we did not know the heartache and privation they knew, especially Dad. Because of them, I often tell couples preparing for marriage, "If you can make the next generation healthier than the one you came from, you've done your job."

It's easy to forget that we all have a history. We all have families of origin that have passed onto us both good and bad traits. It's easy to forget that we all struggle with something, that we know not what's going on in the lives of the people around us, including those we live with. Sometimes it's important to humanize each other by remembering that the same people we have issues with also have moms and dads, families and histories, successes and failures. We're quick to judge without knowing all the facts, we hold onto opinions and talk about each other in ways that we would never want that person to hear, nor would we want that person's parents to hear. That should



make us all pause before we engage in some of the conversations we have!

Thirty years ago as a brand-new priest, I never would have imagined the experiences I would have. The path that I have walked has been difficult at times; sometimes I have stumbled and fallen. As a young priest I used to look at the guys ordained 25+ years and think, "My goodness, they're so OLD," and now I'm that guy! There are things I regret, dumb choices I made, and I've often let pride get in the way of my best work. I used to hear older priests grumble about their ministry, or the burdens of administration, and I would be disappointed. Now I understand what they meant, and I try not to get caught up in such negativity. As I see it, God willing, I have at least 20 more years of active service to render to God and His Church and I hope to become the kind of person my parents have always seen in me.
