### Our Parish Pastoral Council

The Diocese of Orange requires every parish to have a Pastoral Council. This is a group of parishioners who help in a consultative role for the Pastor to make important decisions about the pastoral ministries of the parish. They are to help with visioning and direction, setting the future and making goals to reach them. In the four years I have been your Pastor, I have relied on this group of dedicated people. I have also tried to make sure we had a smooth transition of membership on the Council: the Constitution of the Council, and in fact the expectation of the Diocese, is that parishioners are members for three years with some extra leeway at my discretion. The purpose of this rotation is so that no one is burdened with many years of service, and to refresh and renew the vision of the parish over time. Last week I announced three members who have finished their service. Today I want to show you the current membership of your Council. They are meant to liaison with the various ministries and groups of the parish, to bring to the Council and to me any news or information they believe we need to know, and especially if there is something that needs attention or action. 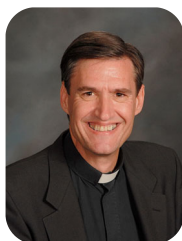
## Self-Help Interfaith Program
