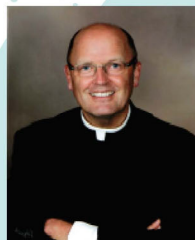

**PASTOR'S CORNER**



**Thanksgiving and Advent**

personally incarnate Christ in our daily lives as His Body the Church.

This weekend is the last Sunday of Ordinary Time; next week when we gather we will begin a new Church Year! This weekend falls between Thanksgiving and Advent, so it seems like a good opportunity to reflect on both.

Thanksgiving is not just an American holiday—it is the way of life of a Christian. As Catholics what we do at every Mass is give thanks: we get this from the Greek word Eucharist, which is from the verb meaning to give thanks. Above and beyond everything else we do at Mass, we give thanks.

It's common that when we celebrate the new year (January 1), we often look back on the year that has been and look forward to the year to come. At Advent we do something similar, though it's not something so bound to the calendar. The first two weeks of Advent look back to how God prepared the world for the coming Messiah, and we look forward to His Second Coming and how we ought to be prepared better than the world was at His First Coming. In the last two weeks of Advent we look "forward" to the immediate preparation of the world for Christ in His Incarnation, and try to be prepared to celebrate the anniversary of Christ's birth so that we can somehow

How Thanksgiving and Advent intersect, then, is a matter of knowing our Faith and being grateful for all God has given us. Beginning with the Incarnation as the first stage of Christ's redemptive act on the Cross, we are grateful for what God has accomplished for our salvation. In Advent we anticipate His return in glory and the culmination of all creation: it's not just some gloomy "end-of-the-world" scene or scary apocalypse: what we await are a new Heaven and a new earth where God's chosen ones (namely us) can experience the resurrection and live forever with the Trinity, Mary & Joseph, the Angels, and all the Saints including our loved ones who have preceded us in death!

This is a big picture of Advent and the things for which we are grateful. In our daily lives of faith and family, work and leisure, joys and sorrows, there is much for which we should give thanks. We thank each other for all the big and little ways we live and love together, and we thank God for His providence in life. Although it is impossible to list everything we have and everything we are, this is the time of year when we can be more intentional about prayers of thanksgiving.

As we enter into this new year of grace, let us take the time to show our gratitude to one another, and to God Who makes all things possible.

Once a year the Finance Board and I are required by Diocesan policy, and by simple good stewardship and transparency, to offer you a summary statement of the finances and pastoral condition of our parish. Below reflect the numbers of people and amounts of money that have served our community for the period of time July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018. That seems like so long ago, and so much has happened in your families and in our parish that it's hard to easily encapsulate all that activity in a few graphs!

*We (SVDP) began the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 with \$2,770. Parishioners gave us an additional \$43,091 to aid the less fortunate among us. This left an ending balance of \$3,442. Thank you for your continuing support for this ministry.*

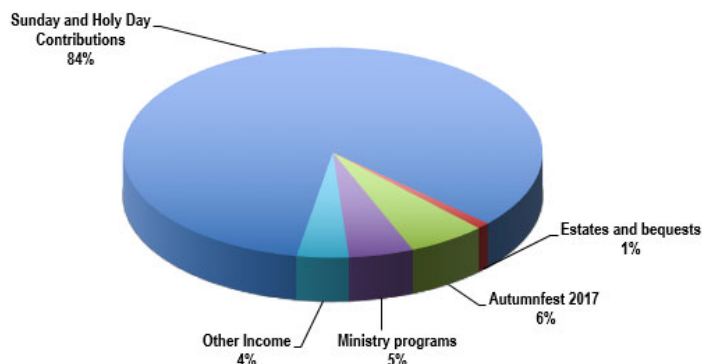

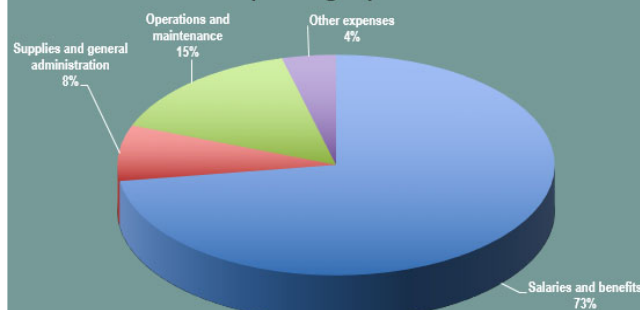
