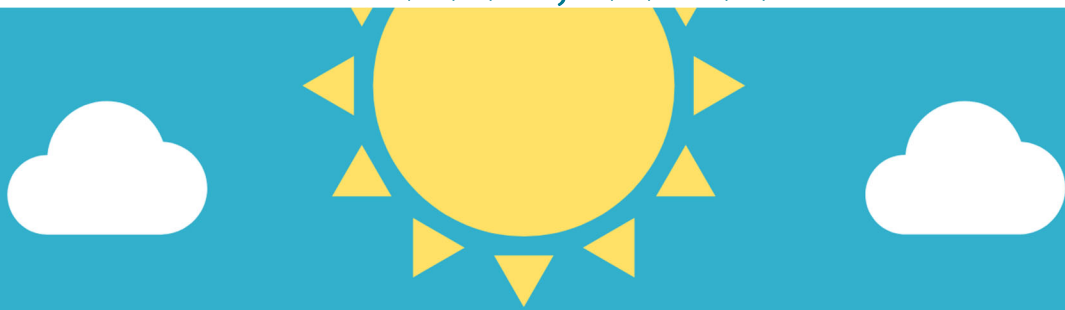

This is my last bulletin article. I'm staring at my computer screen realizing, for once, I have nothing to say... My calendar after June 30 is empty: no more Pastoral Council, Finance Board, or Liturgy Committee meetings, no Mass schedule, no parish appointments.



To be sure, parish life and faith continues, just not on my calendar! I have a few meetings at the Pastoral Center to discuss my new assignment, but not much will happen over the summer. I ask you to pray for my intentions as I move onto my next adventure.
