

# TMIY FAQ

### Q: Why should I join TMIY?

A: Men, in general, talk superficially. We talk about sports, fantasy teams and our kids activities. TMIY provides men an opportunity to discuss their faith, their development as fathers, husbands or single people. In this social media driven world, we all know that life isn't as perfect as it may seem. Life is going to throw us some curveballs. TMIY is a place you can come to strengthen your spiritual core. We encounter this strengthening by reflecting on the presentations and listening to other men and their experiences. TMIY is not a group of "holier than thou" individuals, but a gathering of men who are just trying to become "a better version of themselves". TMIY will help you develop your spiritual muscle and teach you how to become a better man, father and husband.

## Q: Why did we choose such an early time on Friday to have the meetings?

A: We understand the pressures of being a husband and father. Week nights just seemed impossible given the erratic schedules we have in our day to day lives. Saturdays are almost always filled with our children's sporting events. Sundays are a time for Mass and family. So, with that said, we chose Fridays at 5:45 a.m. Coffee, breakfast food and fellowship are available at 5:45 a.m., with the actual program starting at 6:05 a.m. There is a hard stop at 7:15 a.m. so that everyone can get to their jobs at a reasonable time. It has turned out to be a great way to start a Friday and have it carry over into the weekend.

### Q: What is a typical session like?

A: Doors open at 5:45 a.m. for fellowship, coffee and food. The program begins at 6:05 a.m. with announcements from Deacon Henry. We then watch a 20-25 minute video followed by a small group discussion. Group discussions stop at 7:15 a.m. sharp.

### Q: Does it cost any money to join TMIY?

A: Once a year, a \$30 donation is suggested, but not required, to help pay for the program. We want you to come, even if you cannot afford the \$30. We have funds available to help anyone who needs financial assistance.

### Q: How often does TMIY meet?

A: Every Friday when we are in session. There is a extended break for summer and a shorter one at Christmas.

### Q: How many men come every Friday?

A: Attendance is between 35 to 50 men per week, with over 180 registered.

### Q: Is there daycare?

A: Not at this time.
